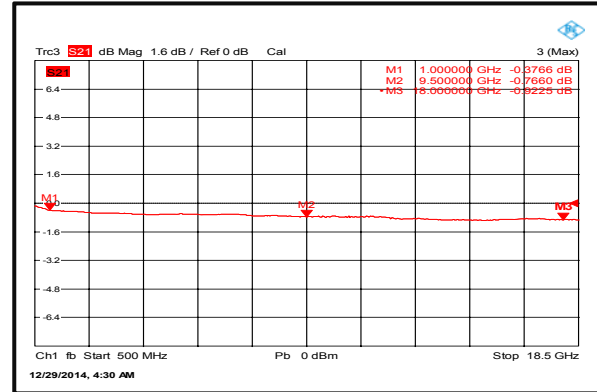

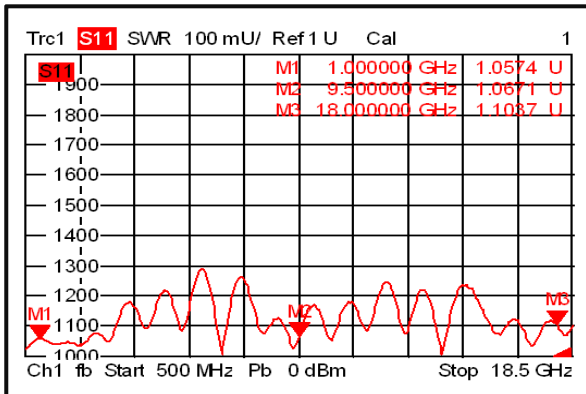

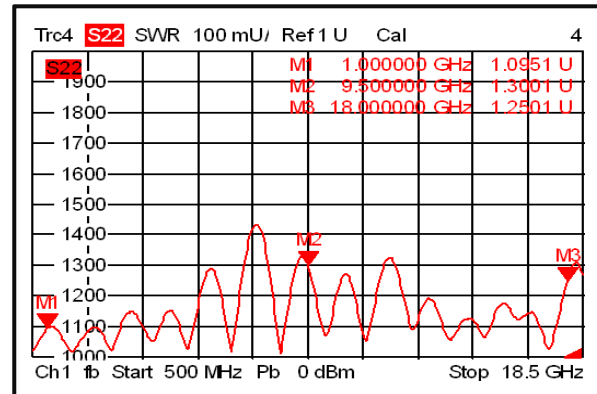
Insertion Loss



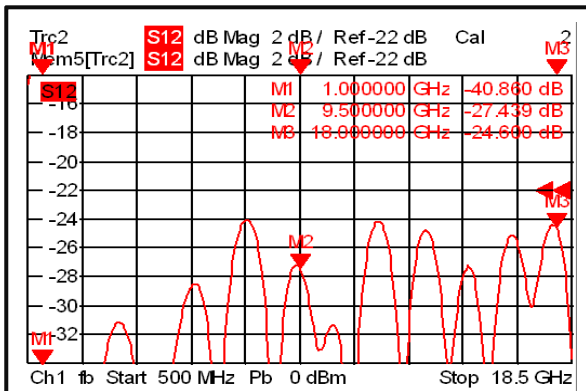
Primary VSWR



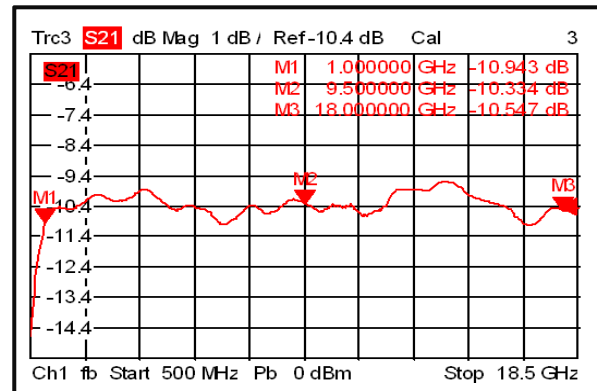
Secondary VSWR

Nominal Coupling

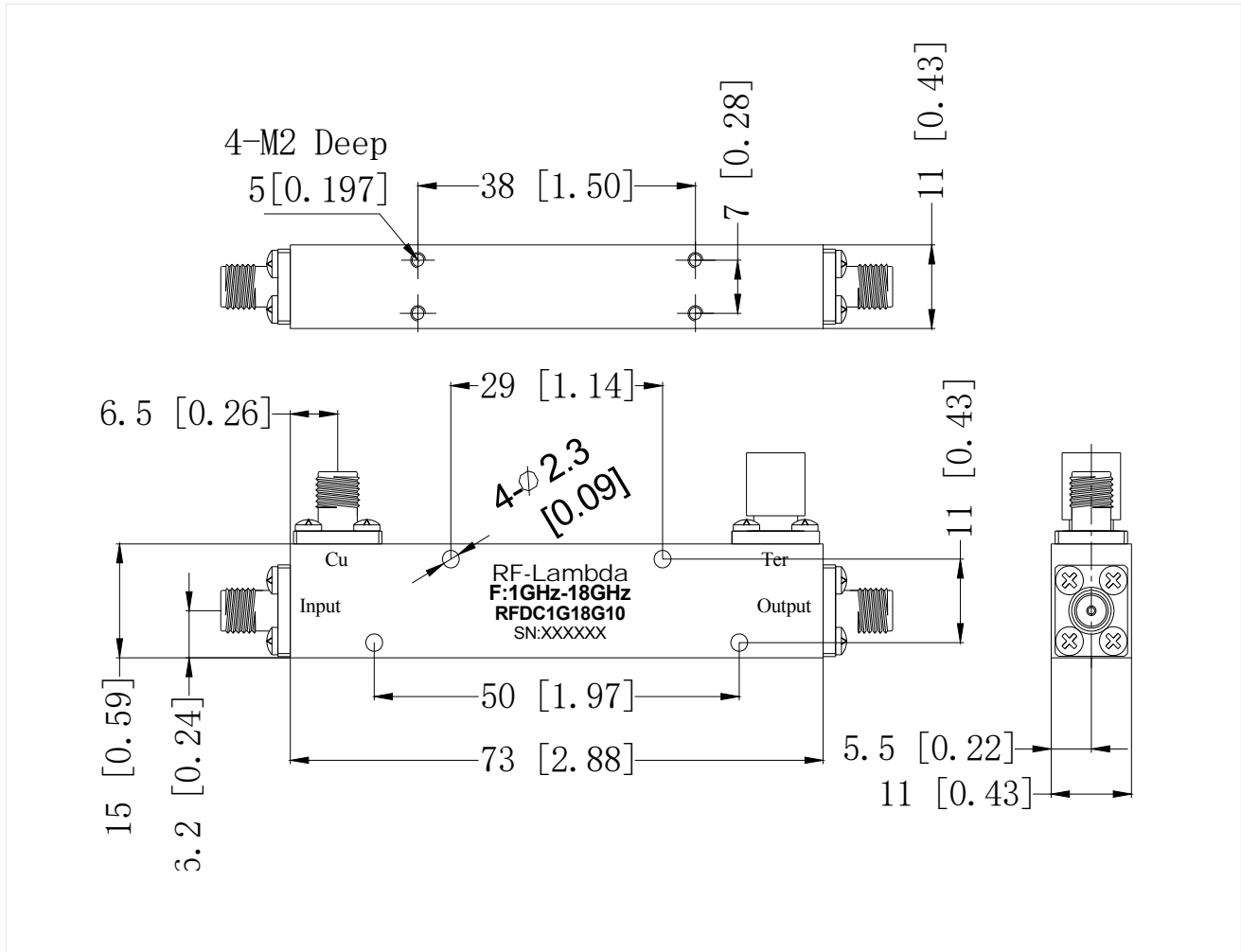
